

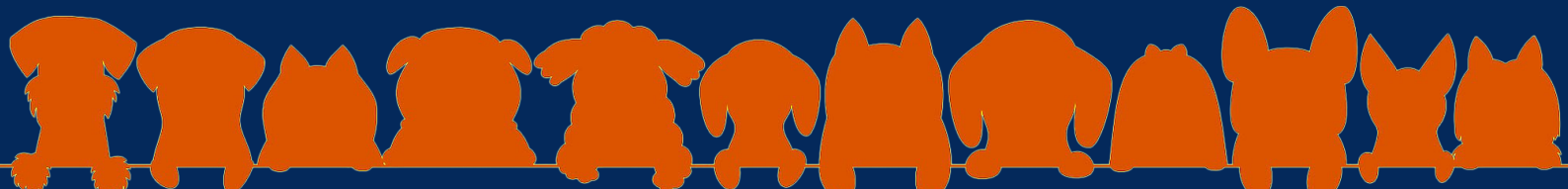

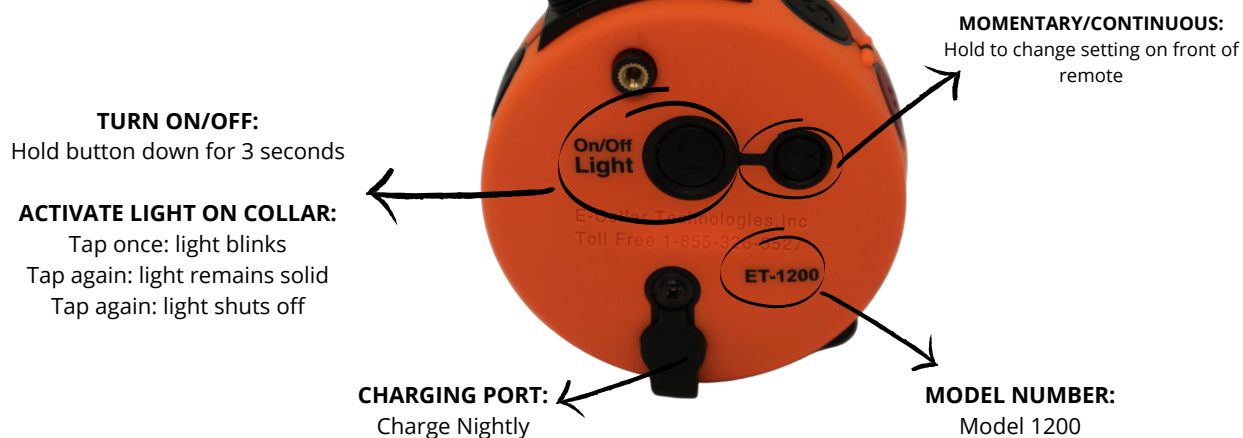

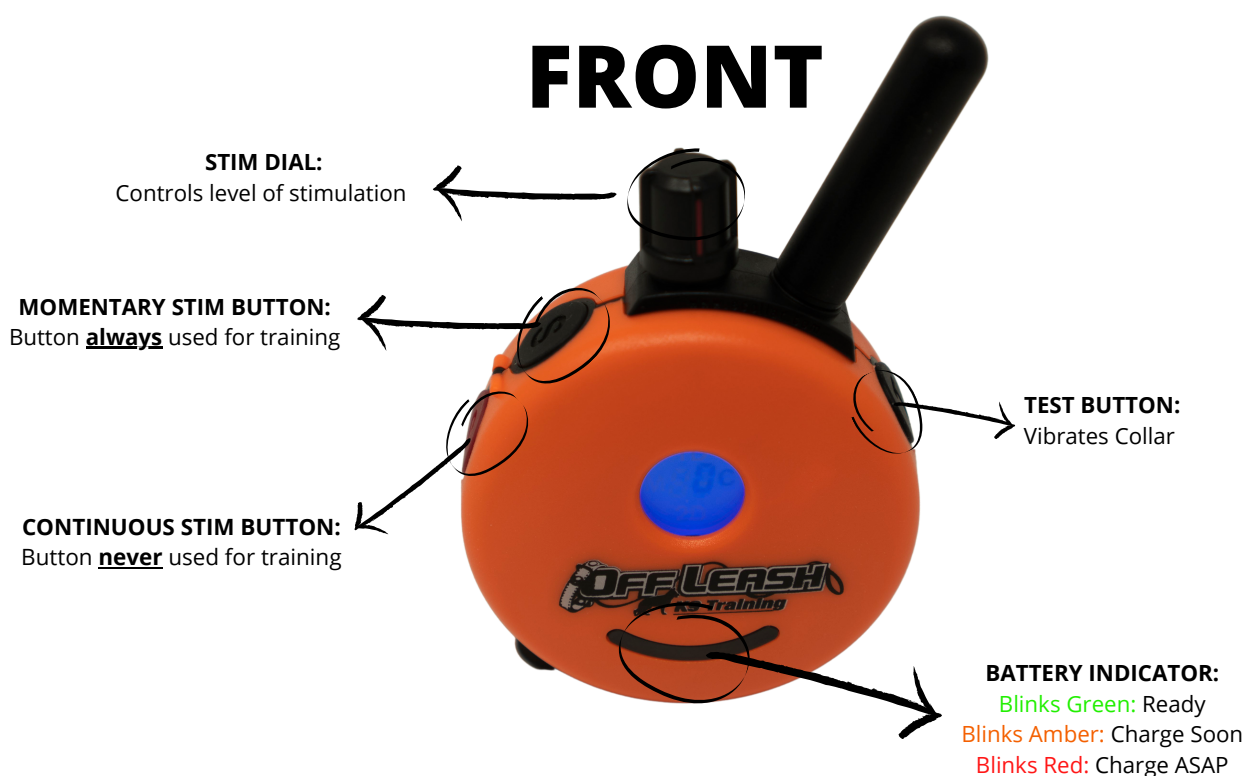

FITTING THE ECOLLAR

HOW TO PROPERLY FIT THE ECOLLAR

INSTRUCTIONS: The collar strap should be tight enough that the contact points are applying light pressure on the dog's neck but it shouldn't be able to slide or re-position itself on the dog's neck. You may have to take a few minutes to get the right adjustment, but this step is very important when working with e-collars. A good rule to follow is that the collar should be a "snug two fingers" from the back of the dog's neck to the collar; meaning, you should not be able to just easily slide two fingers between the collar and the neck, it should be a snug fit between there. Lastly, the collar should be positioned high on the dog's neck from the sides of the dog's neck down to the throat area.

TROUBLESHOOTING

EQUIPMENT

DOG DOES NOT APPEAR TO BE FEELING THE COLLAR:

- ENSURE THE COLLAR IS A TIGHT TWO FINGERS ON YOUR DOG'S NECK.
- HIT THE "TEST" BUTTON ON THE SIDE OF YOUR REMOTE TO ENSURE THE COLLAR IS TURNED ON (IT SHOULD VIBRATES/TONE).
- ENSURE THE PRONGS ON THE COLLAR ARE TIGHTENED DOWN.
- THE COLLAR SHOULD BE POSITIONED HIGH ON THE DOG'S NECK FROM THE SIDES OF THE DOG'S NECK DOWN TO THE THROAT AREA.

DIAL ON THE REMOTE IS STUCK ON A NUMBER:

- PRESS AND HOLD THE STIM KNOB DOWNARD FOR 2-3 SECONDS, THIS WILL UNLOCK THE NUMBER.

DOG IS GETTING A RASH ON THEIR NECK FROM THE COLLAR:

- ENSURE THE COLLAR IS ON A TIGHT TWO FINGERS (TO PREVENT IT FROM LOOSELY RUBBING BACK AND FORTH).
- DO NOT LEAVE THE COLLAR ON YOUR DOG FOR A PERIOD LONGER THAN 8 HOURS PER DAY. ALWAYS TAKE COLLAR OFF WHEN YOUR DOG IS HOME ALONE AND/OR AT NIGHT.

DIAL ON THE REMOTE IS STUCK ON A NUMBER:

- PRESS AND HOLD THE STIM KNOB DOWNARD FOR 2-3 SECONDS, THIS WILL UNLOCK THE NUMBER.

TRAINING CHECKLIST

TAKING YOUR DOG ON AN ADVENTURE

MANDATORY TRAINING ITEMS: Here is a checklist of things that you should always ensure you have with you prior to taking your dog outside for fun and training!



FULLY CHARGED AND TURNED ON OLK9 ECOLLAR



FULLY CHARGED AND TURNED ON OLK9 REMOTE



STANDARD LEASH (RECOMMEND 3'-6')



STANDARD COLLAR WITH ID TAGS



WATER/WATER BOWL



POOP BAGS



TREATS (OPTIONAL)



COME COMMAND

- ✓ **START AT ZERO AND GIVE 1 “CHANCE” PER GRADUAL INCREASE.**
- ✓ **QUICKLY TAP THE BLACK “S” BUTTON AT EXACT SAME TIME YOU ARE SAYING THE COMMAND.**
- ✓ **IF DOG DOESN'T COMPLY, TURN DIAL SLIGHTLY UPWARD PUSH BUTTON WHILE SIMULTANEOUSLY SAYING “COME” AGAIN**
- ✓ **IF DOG DOESN'T COMPLY, TURN DIAL SLIGHTLY UPWARD PUSH BUTTON WHILE SIMULTANEOUSLY SAYING “COME” AGAIN**
- ✓ **REPEAT THE ABOVE UNTIL YOUR DOG MAKES AN EFFORT TO COMPLY WITH THE COMMAND**
- ✓ **ONCE DOG STARTS COMING TOWARDS YOU, GIVE THEM VERBAL ENCOURAGEMENT (“GOOD BOY OR GIRL”) SINCE HE OR SHE IS FOLLOWING COMMAND.**
- ✓ **YOUR DOG SHOULD COME WITHIN ARMS REACH OF YOU. IF YOU HAVE TO TAKE A STEP TO PET HIM OR HER THEN THE DOG IS TOO FAR AWAY, SO CONTINUE WITH THE ABOVE “COME” PROCEDURE UNTIL THEY ARE WITHIN ARMS REACH.**
- ✓ **ENSURE YOU ARE KEEPING IT FUN FOR YOU AND YOUR DOG!**



SIT COMMAND

- ✓ **START AT ZERO AND GIVE 1 “CHANCE” PER GRADUAL INCREASE.**
- ✓ **QUICKLY TAP THE BLACK “S” BUTTON AT EXACT SAME TIME YOU ARE SAYING THE COMMAND.**
- ✓ **IF DOG DOESN'T COMPLY, TURN DIAL SLIGHTLY UPWARD PUSH BUTTON WHILE SIMULTANEOUSLY SAYING “SIT” AGAIN**
- ✓ **IF DOG DOESN'T COMPLY, TURN DIAL SLIGHTLY UPWARD PUSH BUTTON WHILE SIMULTANEOUSLY SAYING “SIT” AGAIN**
- ✓ **REPEAT THE ABOVE UNTIL YOUR DOG MAKES AN EFFORT TO COMPLY WITH THE COMMAND**
- ✓ **ONCE DOG STARTS SITTING, GIVE THEM VERBAL ENCOURAGEMENT (“GOOD BOY OR GIRL”) SINCE HE OR SHE IS FOLLOWING COMMAND.**
- ✓ **IF YOUR DOG GETS UP FROM THE SIT COMMAND BEFORE YOU RELEASE THEM WITH THEIR MAGICAL WORD (“BREAK”), SIMPLY REPEAT ABOVE STEPS.**
- ✓ **ENSURE YOU ARE KEEPING IT FUN FOR YOU AND YOUR DOG!**



PLACE COMMAND

- ✓ USING OPEN HAND OR REMOTE HAND-HOLD IT DIRECTLY OVER THE OBJECT TO GIVE THE DOG A DEFINED TARGET, SHOWING HIM OR HER WHERE YOU WANT HIM TO PLACE.
- ✓ START AT ZERO AND GIVE 1 “CHANCE” PER GRADUAL INCREASE.
- ✓ QUICKLY TAP THE BLACK “S” BUTTON AT EXACT SAME TIME YOU ARE SAYING THE COMMAND.
- ✓ IF DOG DOESN'T COMPLY, TURN DIAL SLIGHTLY UPWARD PUSH BUTTON WHILE SIMULTANEOUSLY SAYING “PLACE” AGAIN. ENSURE YOU ARE USING YOUR OPEN PALM OVER THE OBJECT TO GIVE THEM THE VISUAL CUE.
- ✓ IF DOG DOESN'T COMPLY, TURN DIAL SLIGHTLY UPWARD PUSH BUTTON WHILE SIMULTANEOUSLY SAYING “PLACE” AGAIN
- ✓ REPEAT THE ABOVE UNTIL YOUR DOG MAKES AN EFFORT TO COMPLY WITH THE COMMAND
- ✓ ONCE DOG STARTS PLACING, GIVE THEM VERBAL ENCOURAGEMENT (“GOOD BOY OR GIRL”) SINCE HE OR SHE IS FOLLOWING COMMAND.
- ✓ IF YOUR DOG LEAVES FROM THE PLACE COMMAND BEFORE YOU RELEASE THEM WITH THEIR MAGICAL WORD (“BREAK”), SIMPLY REPEAT ABOVE STEPS.
- ✓ ENSURE YOU ARE KEEPING IT FUN FOR YOU AND YOUR DOG!



DOWN COMMAND

- ✓ **START AT ZERO AND GIVE 1 “CHANCE” PER GRADUAL INCREASE.**
- ✓ **QUICKLY TAP THE BLACK “S” BUTTON AT EXACT SAME TIME YOU ARE SAYING THE COMMAND.**
- ✓ **IF DOG DOESN'T COMPLY, TURN DIAL SLIGHTLY UPWARD PUSH BUTTON WHILE SIMULTANEOUSLY SAYING “DOWN” AGAIN. ENSURE YOU ARE USING YOUR FINGER POINTING DOWNWARD IN ORDER TO GIVE THEM THE VISUAL CUE.**
- ✓ **IF DOG DOESN'T COMPLY, TURN DIAL SLIGHTLY UPWARD PUSH BUTTON WHILE SIMULTANEOUSLY SAYING “DOWN” AGAIN**
- ✓ **REPEAT THE ABOVE UNTIL YOUR DOG MAKES AN EFFORT TO COMPLY WITH THE COMMAND**
- ✓ **ONCE DOG STARTS SITTING, GIVE THEM VERBAL ENCOURAGEMENT (“GOOD BOY OR GIRL”) SINCE HE OR SHE IS FOLLOWING COMMAND.**
- ✓ **IF YOUR DOG GETS UP FROM THE DOWN COMMAND BEFORE YOU RELEASE THEM WITH THEIR MAGICAL WORD (“BREAK”), SIMPLY REPEAT ABOVE STEPS.**
- ✓ **ENSURE YOU ARE KEEPING IT FUN FOR YOU AND YOUR DOG!**



HEEL COMMAND

- ✓ **START WITH THE DOG ON YOUR LEFT-HAND SIDE DIRECTLY BESIDE YOUR LEFT LEG, WITH THE DOG IN A SIT POSITION.**
- ✓ **STARTING THE DOG FROM A SIT, YOU SIMPLY SAY HEEL AND START WALKING. IF DOG DOESN'T START WALKING WITH YOU SAY HEEL AND TAP THE STIMULATION BUTTON.**
- ✓ **FOR HEEL, YOU START AT A LEVEL THAT YOU CAN SEE THE DOG ACKNOWLEDGES AND GETS HIS/HER ATTENTION. LOOK AT THIS LIKE A TAP ON THEIR SHOULDER.**
- ✓ **IF YOU TAP THE BUTTON AND THE DOG IGNORES THE CORRECTION, YOU ARE TOO LOW. IF YOU TAP THE BUTTON AND THE DOG JERKS HIS HEAD, SHAKES, OR VOCALIZES, YOU ARE TOO HIGH.**
- ✓ **ONLY GOING UP ON E-COLLAR UNTIL YOU REACH A LEVEL THAT GETS THE DOG'S ATTENTION. IF YOU GO TOO HIGH ON E-COLLAR, THE DOG WILL START TO FOCUS ON THE STIMULATION AND NOT THE COMMAND.**
- ✓ **WHILE WALKING, SLOW DOWN, SAY YOUR DOG'S NAME, AND THEN COME TO A COMPLETE STOP.**
- ✓ **IMMEDIATELY, INITIATE "SIT" PROTOCOL WHICH IS DESCRIBED ABOVE (PAGE 14).**
- ✓ **THIS SHOULD BE DONE EVERY TIME A HEEL COMMAND IS STOPPED. SAY DOG'S NAME, STOP MOVEMENT, INITIATE SIT PROTOCOL ABOVE.**
- ✓ **YOUR DOG SHOULD NOT LEAVE THE SIT UNTIL HE OR SHE IS RELEASED WITH "BREAK" OR GIVEN A NEW COMMAND (HEEL, DOWN, ETC).**



OFF COMMAND

- ✓ **UTILIZED FOR ANY UNWANTED BEHAVIOR- JUMPING, COUNTER-SURFING, SCRATCHING, DIGGING, BARKING, ETC**
- ✓ **ADJUST THE DIAL TO LOWEST LEVEL REQUIRED TO GET THE DOG'S ATTENTION AND PRESS THE STIM BUTTON WHILE SAYING "OFF" AT THE SAME TIME AS TAPPING THE BUTTON.**
- ✓ **IF HE GOES BACK TO WHATEVER HE OR SHE WAS DOING THEN GO UP FROM THAT LEVEL A LITTLE HIGHER AND "OFF" HIM OR HER AGAIN TAPPING THE BUTTON WHILE USING YOUR STERN VOICE. NO NEED TO YELL OR SCREAM.**
- ✓ **IF YOU TAP THE BUTTON AND THE DOG IGNORES THE CORRECTION, YOU ARE TOO LOW. IF YOU TAP THE BUTTON AND THE DOG JERKS HIS HEAD, SHAKES, OR VOCALIZES, YOU ARE TOO HIGH.**
- ✓ **REPEAT ABOVE STEPS UNTIL DOG STOPS DOING THE UNWANTED BEHAVIOR. USE JUDGEMENT, AS YOU DO NOT WANT TO EXCEED AN INHUMANE LEVEL OF STIMULATION.**
- ✓ **REMEMBER, THE "OFF" COMMAND IS GENERALLY UTILIZED TO PROTECT THE DOGS FROM THEMSELVES. IT'S THE EQUIVALENT OF SLAPPING A TODDLERS HAND BEFORE THEY STICK IT IN A LIGHT SOCKET. YOU DO NOT WANT THEM EATING A ROCK, BITING SOMETHING THAT MAY HURT THEM, ETC.**

TROUBLESHOOTING

TRAINING

DOG DOES NOT APPEAR TO BE FEELING THE COLLAR:

- ENSURE THE COLLAR IS A TIGHT TWO FINGERS ON YOUR DOG'S NECK.
- HIT THE "TEST" BUTTON ON THE SIDE OF YOUR REMOTE TO ENSURE THE COLLAR IS TURNED ON (IT SHOULD VIBRATES/TONE).
- ENSURE THE PRONGS ON THE COLLAR ARE TIGHTENED DOWN.
- THE COLLAR SHOULD BE POSITIONED HIGH ON THE DOG'S NECK FROM THE SIDES OF THE DOG'S NECK DOWN TO THE THROAT AREA.

DOG SEEMS TO BE TOO DISTRACTED:

- TRAIN IN A LOWER DISTRACTED ENVIRONMENT TO ENSURE THAT "YOU" ARE VERY PROFICIENT WITH THE COMMANDS/EQUIPMENT FIRST. THEN, GRADUALLY INCREASE YOUR DURATION, DISTANCE, AND DISTRACTIONS.

DOG IS GETTING A RASH ON THEIR NECK FROM THE COLLAR:

- ENSURE THE COLLAR IS ON A TIGHT TWO FINGERS (TO PREVENT IT FROM LOOSELY RUBBING BACK AND FORTH).
- DO NOT LEAVE THE COLLAR ON YOUR DOG FOR A PERIOD LONGER THAN 8 HOURS PER DAY. ALWAYS TAKE COLLAR OFF WHEN YOUR DOG IS HOME ALONE AND/OR AT NIGHT.

I'M NOT GOOD WITH THE REMOTE:

- THE GOOD NEWS IS, NOBODY IS IN THE BEGINNING! WE RECOMMEND THAT YOU TURN OFF YOUR REMOTE OR TAKE THE COLLAR OFF OF YOUR DOG AND PRACTICE YOUR SPEED AND TIMING ON YOUR REMOTE IN AN EASY ENVIRONMENT!

DOG ISN'T AS GOOD AT THE COMMANDS:

- IF YOU ARE EVER HAVING ISSUES WITH A SPECIFIC COMMAND, GO BACK TO USING LEASH IN CONJUNCTION WITH ECOLLAR TRAINING SYSTEM.
- ENSURE YOU ARE UTILIZING ONE CHANCE PER LEVEL, WITH QUICK INCREASE BETWEEN COMMANDS.
- ENSURE THAT YOU ARE ALWAYS FOLLOWING THROUGH WITH THE COMMANDS THAT YOU HAVE GIVEN.
- ENSURE YOU AREN'T PRACTICING IN AN ENVIRONMENT THAT YOU DO NOT FEEL 100% CONFIDENT AND IN CONTROL IN.

SECTION *Tips* THREE

TRAINING TIPS

MAXIMIZING YOUR ADVENTURE WITH YOUR
DOG

REMINDERS: Here are a few key reminders in order to help maximize your dog's training!



COLLAR ON NON STOP OVER THE NEXT COUPLE WEEKS. ONLY TIME IT'S OFF IS HOME ALONE OR AT NIGHT WHEN YOU ALL ARE SLEEPING. NOT TO EXCEED 8 HOURS PER DAY.



VERY SNUG TWO FINGERS FROM COLLAR TO BACK OF THEIR NECK. THEY CAN GET SORES ON THEIR NECK FROM THE FRICTION OF THE PRONGS RUBBING BACK AND FORTH ON THEIR NECK FROM IT BEING TOO LOOSE.



USE THE REMOTE AS MUCH AS HUMANELY POSSIBLE OVER THE NEXT TWO WEEKS! A) TEACHES THEM THAT THEY HAVE TO LISTEN TO YOU. B) THAT'S THE ONLY WAY YOU WILL GET GOOD WITH THE REMOTE IS PRACTICING



PRESS THE BUTTON AT THE SAME TIME AS YOU GIVE THE COMMAND. ONE CHANCE THEN TURN IT UP! NOT MUCH TIME IN BETWEEN COMMANDS



NEVER LET THEM GET UP FROM A COMMAND UNTIL YOU RELEASE THEM, IF THEY DO, PUT THEM RIGHT BACK INTO THAT SAME POSITION!



NEVER LET THEM GET UP FROM A COMMAND UNTIL YOU RELEASE THEM, IF THEY DO, PUT THEM BACK INTO THAT SAME POSITION!



PRACTICE, PRACTICE, PRACTICE! YOUR DOG HAS HAD MANY MORE HOURS OF TRAINING THAN YOU AT THIS POINT, WORK ON YOUR COMMANDS AND TIMING!



BE CONSISTENT! NEVER LET HER DO SOMETHING DIFFERENT THAN WHAT YOU SAID.



ALWAYS MAKE THE TRAINING FUN AND ON "BREAK" GIVE TONS OF PRAISE!
